Essays may be typed or handwritten and should include:

- -Your name, grade, and homeroom/classroom teacher
- -The name and a description of your charity
- -Reasons why you think we should donate the money to the charity
- -Explanations about how this charity will impact people and/or a personal connection about how the charity helped you or someone you know. Special consideration will be given to essays that discuss how the charity has made a local impact
